Advantages of ARMINIUS

- > Strong mass growth at the the beginning
- > Very low susceptibility to rust
- > Pronounced dry matter yield in the first cut
- > Recommended for intercropping

Mass growth at the beginning

Tendency to winter kill

Susceptibility to rust

Dry matter yield, 1st cut
