Maturity group: very early/early (2)

Listing: since 2017

Advantages of ARMINIUS

- Strong mass growth at the the beginning
- Very low susceptibility to rust
- Pronounced dry matter yield in the first cut
- Recommended for intercropping

Variety assessment of ARMINIUS

Characteristic	Score	Rating
Mass growth at the beginning	5	medium
Tendency to winter kill	6	medium to high
Susceptibility to rust	4	low to medium
Dry matter yield, 1st cut	6	medium to high

(1 = very low, very early / 9 = very strong, very high, very late)
